  - v) The Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and Agency should submit a certificate/ affidavit to the effect that it has not been blacklisted by any Govt./PSU/ Autonomous/Semi Government body of both central and any state government in the last five years.
  - vi) In the case of partnership, the Bidder, to qualify for the award of contract, shall submit a written power of attorney authorizing the signatories of the bid to participate in the bid. Memorandum of understanding/partnership deed shall be provided in case the bidder is a partnership. One of the members of the partnership, to be nominated as in charge and this authorization shall be covered in the power of Attorney signed by the legally authorized signatories of all members of partnership Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and Agency. Managing Director can authorize any person/authorized signatory.
  - vii) The bidder shall submit full details of his ownership and control.
  - viii) Bidder shall submit a copy of TAN & PAN card under the Income Tax Act.
  - *ix)* Bidder must submit copies of all documents required, duly self attested, along with technical bid of the e-tender.

  - xi) Bidder is required to confirm and declare with his bid that no agent, middleman or any intermediary has been, or will be engaged to provide any services, or any other item or work related to the award and performance of this contract. They will have to further confirm and declare that no Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and Agency commission or any payment which may be construed as Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and an Agency commission has been or will be paid and that the e-tender price will not include any such amounts. If the authorities subsequently find any such evidence to the contrary, it reserves the right to declare the Bidder as non-compliant and declare any contract if already awarded to the Bidder null and void.
- 2. One Bid per Bidder:- Each bidder shall submit only one e-tender either by himself or through authorized person.
- 3. Cost of Bid:- The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation, methodology study and submission of his bid and Pt. B. D. Sharma, UHS, Rohtak shall in no case be responsible or liable for those incurred costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the e-tender process.
- 4. Visit to Department:- The bidder is required to provide lifting and transportation of general waste services to Pt. B. D. Sharma, UHS, Rohtak and is advised to visit and acquaint themselves with the operational system. The cost of such visit and survey shall be borne by the bidder. The Bidder shall certify that he has undertaken a visit to the work site and is aware of the operational conditions prior to the submission of the e-tender documents.
- 5. The E-tenderer should submit his e-tender in three parts i. e. (i) Earnest Money (ii) Technical Bid (iii) Price Bid. Each part should be submitted as under:-

- (i) Earnest Money and e-tender fees should be submitted through online mode as per detail given in the e-tender.

- 6. The bidder is expected to examine all instructions, Forms, Terms and conditions in the e-tender document. Failure to furnish all information required by the e-tender document or submission of e-tender not meeting the eligibility criteria responsive to the e-tender document in every respect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in rejection of his bid.
- 7. The bidder shall not make or cause to be made any alteration, erasure or obliteration to the text of the e-tender document.
- 8. The bidder shall check the pages of all documents and in the event of discovery of any discrepancy or missing pages, the bidder shall inform the Office of the Registrar, Pt. B. D. Sharma, UHS, Rohtak before submitting the bid.
- 9. In case the bidder has any doubt about the meaning of anything contained in the e-tender document, he shall seek clarification during the PRE BID MEETING on the designated date and time as per Notice Inviting e-tender. Any such clarification if agreed to by Pt. B.D Sharma UHS Rohtak would be issued as addendum to the e-tender document on the Pt. B.D Sharma UHS, Rohtak web site only and issued bid document shall stand corrected / detailed to that extent.
- 10. Except for any such written clarification by the Department, which is expressly stated to be an addendum to the e-tender document issued by the Office of the Registrar, Pt. B.D Sharma UHS, Rohtak no written or oral communication, presentation or explanation by any other employee of the Department shall be taken to bind or fetter the Department under the contract.
- 11. Bids and all accompanying document shall be in English or in Hindi. In case any accompanying documents are in other languages, it shall be accompanied by an English translation. The English version shall prevail in matters or interpretation.
- 12. The bidder shall, on or before the date given in the Notice Invitation to E-tender, submit his bid through the e- portal.
- 13. One copy of the e-tender document and Addenda, if any, thereto with each page signed and stamped shall be annexed to acknowledge the acceptance of the same.
- 14. Bid shall be addressed to the Registrar, Pt. B.D Sharma UHS, Rohtak and submitted through e- portal as described above.
- 15. Bidder shall quote the rates in Indian Rupees for the entire contract on a 'single responsibility' basis such that the E-tender price covers contractor's all obligations mentioned in or to be reasonably inferred from the e-tender document in respect of the Services related to lifting and transportation of general waste at Pt. B.D Sharma UHS, Rohtak. This includes all the liabilities of the contractor such as cost of uniform and identity cards of personnel deployed by the contractor and all other statutory liabilities like Minimum Wages, as approved by Dy. Commissioner, Rohtak, ESI, EPF contributions, service charges / Admn. Charges, excluding all kinds of taxes as applicable etc. which should be clearly stated by the contractor (Please refer Annexure-VI).
- 16. The rates quoted by the Bidder shall be exclusive of GST as applicable.
- 17. Conditional bids / offers will be summarily rejected.

- 18. The Form of Bid should be completed in all respects duly signed and stamped by an authorized and empowered representatives of the Bidder. If the Bidder comprises a partnership Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and Agency, bid shall be signed by a duly authorized representative and relevant power of attorney shall be attached.
- 19. The contract shall be valid initially for one year but to be reviewed after completion of one year period and may be extended for another one year, subject to satisfactory services only.
- 20. Any e-tender not accompanied by Bid Security shall be rejected.
- 21. Bid Securities of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them at the earliest after expiry of the final bid validity and latest on or before the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the award of the contract. No interest shall be payable on the same.
- 22. Bid Security of the successful bidder shall be returned on receipt of Performance Security/ Bank Guarantee in the Department and after signing the contract agreement.
- 23. Bid Security shall be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or modifies his bid (unless with consent of Pt. B.D Sharma UHS, Rohtak) during the period of E-tender validity.
- 24. Bid Security shall be forfeited if the successful bidder refuses or neglects to execute the Contract or fails to furnish the required Performance Security/ Bank Guarantee within the time as specified by the Department.
- 25. The bidder shall submit one copy of the e-tender document and addenda, if any thereto, with each page of this document signed and stamped to confirm the acceptance of the terms & conditions of the e-tender by the bidder.
- 26. The documents comprising the bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and all pages of the bid shall be signed by a person or persons duly authorized to sign on behalf of the bidder. All pages of the bid, where entries or amendments have been made, shall be signed by the person or persons signing the bid.
- 27. The bid shall contain no alterations, omissions or additions except those to comply with instruction issued by the Department, or are necessary or correct errors made by the bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialed/signed and dated by the person or persons signing the bid.
- 28. The e-tender shall remain valid and open for acceptance for a period of 06 months from the last date of submission of e-tender.
- 29. The authorized representatives of the Pt. B.D Sharma UHS, Rohtak will open the Technical Bids in the presence of the Bidders or their representatives who may choose to attend at the appointed place, date and time.
- 30. The bid of any bidder who does not meet the eligibility criteria and / or has not complied with one or more of the conditions prescribed in the terms & conditions will be summarily rejected. Technical evaluation of only eligible bids shall be carried out.
- 31. Incomplete/ Conditional bids will also be summarily rejected.
- 32. Financial bids of only the technically qualified bidders will be opened for evaluation in the presence of qualified bidders.
- 33. Right to accept / reject any or all Bids: -
  - Pt. B.D Sharma UHS, Rohtak is not bound to accept the lowest or any bid and may at any time by notice in writing to the bidders terminate the e-tendering process.
  - Pt. B.D Sharma UHS, Rohtak may terminate the contract if it is found that the contractor is black listed on previous occasions by any of the Departments/institution/local bodies/ municipalities/ public sector undertakings, etc.
  - If the successful bidder fails to furnish the performance security/bank guarantee or fails to
    execute the agreement, the authorities may terminate the contract. In such an eventuality,
    earnest money deposited shall stand forfeited.

- 34. Pt. B.D Sharma UHS, Rohtak will award the contract to the successful evaluated bidder whose bid has been found to be responsive and who is eligible and qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily as per the terms and conditions incorporated in the bidding document.
- 35. The authorities will communicate the successful bidder by email and Registered post that his bid has been accepted. This letter (hereinafter and in the condition of contract called the "Letter of Award") shall prescribe the amount which Department will pay to the contractor in consideration of the execution of work/services by the contractor as prescribed in the contract.
  - The successful bidder will be required to execute an agreement in the form specified in Annexure –IV within a period of 7 days from the date of issue of Letter of Award but before the work is taken up for execution.
  - The successful bidder shall be required to furnish a Performance Security/Bank Guarantee within 15 days of receipt of 'Letter of Award' for an amount equal to 10% (Ten Percent) of the estimated total cost of the contract for one year, in the form of Bank Guarantee from a commercial bank in an acceptable form (Annexure –VI) in favor of the Registrar, Pt. B.D Sharma UHS, Rohtak. The Performance Security/Bank Guarantee shall remain valid up to clearance of all dues. In case the contract period is extended further, the validity of Performance Security shall also be extended by the contractor accordingly.
  - Failure of the successful bidder to comply with the requirements of above clauses shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of Bid Security.
- 36. The personnel (if any) hired by the service provider for this service shall for the purposes of this contract be the employees of the Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and Agency who will be responsible to provide all fringe benefits viz. PF, ESI facilities to them. The personnel (if any) so deployed by the Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and Agency will not have any legal claim under provisions of Industrial Dispute Act and Contract Labour Act against Pt. B. D. Sharma UHS, Rohtak not being employees of Pt. B. D. Sharma UHS, Rohtak.
- 37. Penal Provisions:-
  - (a) In case the service provider fails to commence the work as stipulated in the agreement, the University Authorities reserve the right to impose and recover penalty as detailed below:-
    - (i) 2% (two percent) of cost of order/agreement per week up to four weeks delays in commencement of work.
    - (ii) After four weeks delay, the authorities may cancel the agreement and get this job carried out preferably at the same rate as of L1, from L2/L3 and on if L2/L3 does not agree then through any Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and other Agency from the other bidder. The difference in cost, if any, will be recovered from the defaulting service provider as damages and he shall be black listed for a period of three years from participating in such types of e-tenders and his security deposit shall also be forfeited, if so warranted.
  - (b) The service provider shall comply with all the relevant laws and statutory requirements covered under various Labour Acts, Minimum Wages Acts, Contractual Labour (Regulation & Abolition Act 1970, EPF, ESI etc. with regard to the personnel (if any) engaged by him for lifting and transportation of General Waste. It will be the responsibility of the service provider to provide certified details of manpower deployed by him on monthly basis in the 'UHS' and to the Labour Department in the appropriate format by 3<sup>rd</sup> of the succeeding month. The default shall attract a penalty at the rate of 2% (two percent) per month on the monthly wages bill of the concerned month.
  - (c) If the contractor is found that he is not providing the satisfactory services as per contract, the contractor may be penalized the amount of Rs.2000/- at first occasion, Rs.5000/- at second occasion and Rs.10000/- at third occasion. Even then, if the services are not improved by the contractor, then the authority will be at liberty to terminate the contract after issuing show cause notice and till the maturity of subsequent contract the continuation will be got done at the risk and cost of the contractor recoverable from his security /bank guarantee.
  - (d) The competent authority for imposing the penalty shall be the Vice-Chancellor, Registrar, Director and Medical Superintendent.
- 38. The persons if so deployed shall be under the overall control and supervision of the contractor and the contractor shall be liable for payment of their wages etc. and all other dues which the contractor is liable to pay under the various Labour Regulations and other statutory provisions (i.e. EPF/ESI).

- 39. The contractor shall ensure compliance of General Waste Management Rules, 2016 and/ or any other statutory rules framed by the Government from time to time regarding General Waste.
- 40. The institute shall not be liable to the payment of any compensation to any of the staff so deployed by the contractor on duty for any accident suffered while lifting & transportation of the General waste.
- 41. The Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and Agency shall submit the bill in the MG Branch, Director Office, PGIMS, Rohtak on reimbursement basis on Ist of every succeeding month for making payment on the reimbursement basis. The payment will be released after the deduction of penalty, if any, imposed by the competent authority as per contract agreement. The Income Tax or any other statutory levy/tax as applicable will be payable by service provider and shall be deducted at source as per law. The Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and Agency shall also submit an affidavit/ undertaking along with the bill that the Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and Agency has complied with all the applicable laws and have ensured statutory compliances to all its workers (if any) hired for providing the service under this contract.
  - 42. Any liabilities arising out of any litigation (including those in consumer courts) due to any act of service provider's personnel shall be directly borne by the service provider including all compensation/ damage/ expenses/ fines/ deaths of personnel while on duty. The concerned service provider personnel shall attend the court as and when required. Any liability arising due to penalty/ damages etc. from any statutory authorities like EPF/ ESI authorities etc. shall be borne only by the vendor and in no case the same shall pass on to the institute on any pretext by the vendor.
  - 43. The Pt. B.D Sharma UHS Rohtak does not recognize any master servant relationship with any of the workers of the service provider. The contract worker (if any) hired by the Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and Agency is the employee of the service provider and can in no way claim any right for regularization of service with the Pt. B. D. Sharma, UHS, Rohtak.
  - 44. The service provider shall ensure full compliance with tax laws of India with regard to this contract and shall be solely responsible for the same. The Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and Agency shall submit copies of acknowledgements as a proof of filing of returns every year and shall keep the Employer fully indemnified against liability of tax, interest, penalty etc. of the Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and Agency in respect thereof, which may arise.
  - 45. <u>Force Majeure</u>: If at any time during the period of the contract, either party is subject to force majeure, which can be termed as natural disasters or, acts of God etc. which may prevent either party to discharge its obligation, the affected party shall promptly notify the other party about the happening of such an event. Neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate the contract in respect of such performance of their obligations. The obligations under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after the event has come to an end or ceased to exist. If the performance of any obligation under the contract is prevented or delayed by reason of the event beyond a period mutually agreed to if any or 21 days, whichever is more, either party may at its option terminate the contract.
  - 46. Dispute Resolution: -
    - (a) Any dispute and or difference arising out of or relating to this contract will be resolved through joint discussion of the authorized representatives of the concerned parties. However, if the disputes are not resolved by joint discussions, then the matter will be referred for adjudication to a sole Arbitrator appointed by the Vice-Chancellor, Pt. B. D. Sharma, University of Health Sciences, Rohtak.
    - (b) The award of the sole Arbitrator shall be final and binding on all the parties. The arbitration proceeding's shall be governed by Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time.
    - (c) The cost of Arbitration shall be borne by the defaulter. During the pendency of the arbitration proceeding and currency of contract, neither party shall be entitled to suspend the work/service to which the dispute relates on account of the arbitration and payment to the Cooperative Labour and Construction Societies consisting of all Schedule Caste members and Agency shall continue to be made in terms of the contract. Arbitration proceedings will be held at Rohtak.
  - 47. <u>Jurisdiction of Court</u>: The courts at Rohtak shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to try all disputes, if any, arising out of this agreement between the parties.
