

Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences Rohtak


Applications on plain paper are invited to fill up the vacant post of Medical Officer under the DTC scheme, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, Co-ordinated by NDDTC, AIIMS, New Delhi at SDDTC, Institute of Mental Health on contract basis of Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak for a period of six months or till the completion of scheme, whichever is earlier. The applications, complete in all respect, along with certificates/ testimonials in support of educational qualifications, permanent registration with the MCI/State Medical council/ Nursing Council or any State Nursing Council in India/RCE registration certificate, proof of date birth, along with any other documents in support of additional qualifications i.e. medals, prizes etc, must reach the O/o Director-cum-CEO, IMH, Pt. B.D. Sharma UHS, Rohtak by 18.04.2026. The applications must also mention their complete correspondence address, including contact number and bio-data. Note:-

- The candidates are requested to visit time to time the University Website i.e. pgimsrohtak.ac.in & www.uhsr.ac.in regularly for further updates. regarding screening test, Interview/eligible/Non-eligible candidature etc.
- The Institute has a right to withdraw the advertise posts at any stage.
- Age and qualification will be counted up to the date of interview.
- The appointment will be initially offered for a period of six months and maybe extended depending upon the satisfactory performance of the candidate and the requirement of the scheme.
- This appointment will be made for the DTC scheme, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, Co-ordinated by NDDTC, AIIMS, New Delhi. The appointment will not vest any right to claim by the candidate for the regular appointment or permanent absorption in PGIMS Rohtak or continued for the project.
- The candidate will initially be shortlisted based on the qualifications and their experience. Only shortlisted candidate will be called for the interview.
- Only eligible candidates will be called telephonically/email/letter for the interview. No other candidates will be entertained on the day of the interview.
- Expiry of scheme: the contract will automatically expire on completion of the scheme earlier in case of withdrawal of support by the funding agency. The engagement in the scheme is purely temporary and co-terminus with the scheme. The contractual appointment can be terminated at any time by either side by giving one day notice or salary in lieu thereof.
- All disputes will be subjected to the jurisdiction of the court of law at Rohtak.
