Prof. V. P. Gupta and Dr. K. K. Kalra could not attend the meeting and were granted leave of absence.

Worthy Vice Chancellor informed that our University received accreditation from NAAC on 22.02.2017. First AQAR was filed on 04.05.2018 and acknowledgement was received through Email on 10.05.2018. The Vice Chancellor also informed that the College of Pharmacy of our University has been awarded 38th rank by NIRF out of 1113 PCI degree approved Pharmacy institutions in the country. MDRA ranking of the University for PG medical courses is under process. He also informed that there is steep improvement in diagnostic facilities of Radiology, Biochemistry and Pathology. Further improvement is taking place in respect of all laboratories. Now there is no waiting list for MRI. It was also informed that training programmes for Non-Physician Health Workers shall be strengthened in the interest of patient care. The University has around 60 ventilators as of now and further purchase would be made in due course of time. Special training of Pharmacists and Nurses shall be conducted regularly in order to prevent nosocomial infections. Separate AHUs shall be in place wherever needed. The Chairman, IQAC apprised the House that widening of roads is taking place so that arrival in Emergency and Trauma facility for critically ill patients become hassle fee.

3. Presentation on strengthening of ICU care.



He gave the details of facilities available and emphasized on further development in the interest of patients of Haryana and nearby areas who come to ICU. The House appreciated the presentation made by Dr. Dhruva Chaudhary and members gave suggestions for further strengthening of this facility.

4. Presentation on biomedical waste management.

Dr. Sukhbir Singh DMS I/c gave a presentation on Biomedical Waste Management. He explained the current practice as per the regulations of Haryana State Pollution Control Board. He presented the pollution data of the hospital. The DMS I/c was requested to work out the possibility and advantage of having our own incinerator. It was suggested that the needles/syringes/sharp edged scrap need be disposed off in plastic boxes instead polybags.

5. Inviting suggestions for further development of the University in light of NAAC observations.

a. It was suggested by Dr. Bipin Batra that UHS should have greater environment sensitivity and needs to have Green Hospital practices in place where non-conventional energy sources may be utilised in the interest of public. (Action Registrar, Dean, Medical Superintendent)
