The Vice-Chancellor thanked all outgoing members of IQAC for their valuable inputs as the IQAC of the University was reconstituted recently. He welcomed new members of IQAC from within the university and outside experts. Mr. Anil Relia and Dr. Mahesh Verma had conveyed their inability to attend the meeting and they were granted leave of absence by the Chairman of IQAC.

In the beginning, the Vice-Chancellor gave the background of the University, including details of constituent Colleges and affiliated Colleges. He narrated the achievements of constituent Colleges. It was brought to the knowledge of members that ETP (effluent treatment plant) is being established by the University and the tender has been floated again as only one party quoted during first circulation. The STP (sewage treatment plant) has been operationalised as per norms of National Green Tribunal.

PWD has been instructed to install equipment for harvesting of solar energy on buildings being constructed newly as part of green Hospital practices.

Dr. Rajeev Gupta presented a talk on Mental Health Care Act, that was appreciated by the audience. He gave the details of the act what is very important for maintaining the health issues of people suffering from mental ailments. Dr. BK Rao took part in deliberations regarding MHC act.

Dr. Geeta Ahlawat presented a talk on filing Indian Patent. She sensitized the members regarding burning issue of patenting innovative research work. Dr. RS Jolly briefed the audience regarding Indian and Foreign national patents.

After thorough discussions, following decisions were taken:

1. The issues pertaining to MHC act shall be taken up by the authorities with the government so that MHRB is constituted in the interest of patients and the state of Haryana.
2. University authorities shall take up the matter with the DC and the Commissioner to get land for making halfway homes for patients suffering from mental illness. As many homes shall be established as needed for catering to the needs of whole Haryana. The Vice-Chancellor emphasised on actionable points in relation to implementation of MHC act on ground reality.
3. Dr. BK Rao gave suggestions regarding NABH accreditation for our hospital. He was requested to depute some young professional to provide gap analysis of our hospital before being filed the application for accreditation. The Medical Superintendent was requested to send the communication to NABH to this effect.
4. In the interest of the University, IPR policy shall be finalized shortly to give boost to young scientist and sensitize those who do innovative research and wish to file patents. The Vice-Chancellor informed that a committee has already been constituted for this purpose. It was approved by the house to co-opt Dr. RS Jolly as expert member of this committee.
5. A seminar on IPR shall be organised by the University for Faculty Members to sensitize the teachers for filing up the patents. The speakers may be Dr. RS Jolly, Dr. Geeta Ahlawat and Dr. Rahul Taneja from DST, Haryana.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to chair. The minutes were approved subject to confirmation in the next IQAC meeting.
